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One on One Workshops Volume 2 List of threads, ribbons and other necessities

Hints and Tips:

Needles

Use size 8 or 9 Crewel needle for 2 strands of thread and size 9 or 10 for 1 strand

Use a size 5 straw needle for the Cast-on Stitch - long straw needle is essential for this stitch.

Use a size 3 or 5 straw/milliner's needle for Perlé thread

Use size 18 or 20 chenille needle for 7mm ribbon, size 20 or 22 for 4mm ribbon

Use size 22 or 24 for 2mm ribbon

Please note: Many of the threads and some of the ribbons used are left over from the packs from Volume 1. You will not need to purchase these again, unless you have run out of them.

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What else you need:

- 1) Mill Hill glass seed beads blue 00168 or any small blue or lavender seed bead you have in stock
- 2) Pre-printed bird and leaves in full colour from www.dicraft.co.za OR a 15x15cm (6 inch) block of fine white cotton, polycotton or vilene/interfacing
- 3) 24 gauge wire with a white or green plastic coating
- 4) Clear anti-fray liquid
- 5) Nail clippers or wire cutters
- 6) A black, permanent laundry marker
- 7) Pre-printed bird in full colour is available from our website and shops- see 2) above
- 8) 4 inch (10cm) hoop
- 9) Use any white translucent metallic thread I used Kreinik blending filament number 32 for the bird
- 10) Polyester toy filling or quilting wool
- 11) 6 or 7mm round wooden, glass or plastic beads, with a large hole.
- 12) Small pair of pliers or needle gripper
- 13) Fluffy green wool -any green wool with a slightly uneven texture
- 14) A 15 x 15 cm (6 inch) block of white felt
- 15) Blue water-erasable pen, 4B pencil or even better, a fine black Pigma micron pen
- 16) Five or six 15 x 15 cm (6 inch) blocks of water-soluble fabric
- 17) Brown or black stamen available from cake decorating shops
- 18) Mill Hill Frosted Glass Beads 62044 or any orange bead
- 19) Wooden, glass or plastic bead about 3 to 4mm
